Mayssoun Azzam

Mayssoun Azzam is one of the most prominent media figures in the Arabic world. Working for the Dubai-based Al-Arabiya news channel as a news presenter, program anchor, interviewer, and lecturer. She has interviewed prominent figures and decision makers. Her reputation as a highly professional media expert qualified her to work as an instructor at the American University in Dubai. She is focusing her work on humanitarian issues and in promoting many campaigns with the United Nations and humanitarian organizations.
