ESCWA has prepared this logistics note to facilitate your participation in the Third Arab Forum for Equality, 4–5 June 2024 at Semiramis InterContinental Hotel in Cairo, Corniche El Nil, P.O Box: 60, 11511 Cairo – Egypt.

Venue, date and meeting language

The Third Arab Forum for Equality will be held at Semiramis Intercontinental Hotel in Cairo on 4–5 June 2024. Logistical and substantive details are available on the Forum website at <u>https://afe-2024.unescwa.org</u>.

The working languages of the Forum are Arabic and English. The Forum will be held in Arabic and simultaneous interpretation will be available from Arabic into English and French. Sign language interpretation will also be provided.



Registration

All participants of the Third Arab Forum for Equality are kindly required to register via the link: <u>https://indico.un.org/</u> <u>event/1009565/</u>. Registration is essential to ensure access to the venue, facilitate recognition by the organizers, and address security requirements.



Air travel reservations and ticketing for ESCWA-sponsored participants will be arranged by the ESCWA Travel Unit. Roundtrip tickets will be issued in economy class on the least expensive route, in accordance with United Nations rules and regulations. Participants will be contacted directly by ESCWA regarding their airline ticket arrangements. Participants attending the meeting at their own cost are responsible for making their own travel arrangements, including ticketing and insurance.

Visas for entry to Egypt are the responsibility of the participant. Participants who may need visa entry to Egypt are encouraged to proceed to the Embassy of Egypt in their respective countries and apply to the visa as soon as possible.

On Tuesday, June 4, sponsored participants are kindly requested to bring their passports, original airline ticket boarding pass, land transportation/taxi receipt/invoice or train receipt/invoice to the meeting venue for confirmation and issuance of their daily subsistence allowance, which will take place on June 5. Collection and review of documents provided will be undertaken by ESCWA staff.



Participants are urged to book their accommodation for their stay as soon as possible.

All hotel expenses will be settled by the participants directly with the hotel.

No receipt is required to receive this allowance.
